

2016 Newsletter

Dec 9th: Bitter cold out, maybe getting old but I didn't want to fish in it.

Dec 8th: Took the boat & trailer up to Snake Creek Marine to buy a grease hub cover for the trailer that we couldn't buy locally. Had to stop on the way home to fish a short while. Caught 8 bass.

Dec 7th: Lost a trailer tire on the way to the river to fish with a friend. Took us a few hours to get enough parts just to fix it enough to use the trailer. Then fished for 1 1/2hrs and caught 4 bass.

Dec 2nd -6th: Deer hunting, shot a doe on the 6th.

Dec 1st: Fished with Ed Bardzel for 3hrs this morning. We did great until the wind picked up making it hard to finesse fish. We caught 23 nice bass from 14" to 17".

Nov Totals: Smallmouth Bass 626, Walleye 23, Northern Pike 2, Perch 1, Hog Nose Sucker 1, Total Fish - 653 fish

Nov 30th: Caught up on computer work and went to dinner with my great relatives.

Nov 28 & 29: Hunted deer saw 2 bucks too small to shoot each day....same bucks!

Nov 27th: Fished for a couple of hours in the morning with Nate Touchner. We caught 21 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 26th: cleared out some shooting lanes at my deer stand.

Nov 25th: Fished with Rick and Ricky Jows today. The sky was cloudy and the water clear and 37 degrees. We caught 25 fish with 1 walleye in the mix.

Nov 24th: Happy Thanksgiving!

Nov 23rd. Truck getting serviced today.

Nov 22nd: Fished with Ed Bardzel. The sky was partly cloudy and the water mostly clear. We caught 26 fish today with 1 walleye in the mix.

Nov 20 & 21st: High wind advisory! rescheduled charters for next spring!

Nov 19th: Went bear hunting just up to my little 50 acres. Saw nothing and at 11:00AM the city neighbors started target shooting a few hundred rounds and scared everything out of the area! IT WAS ALWAYS AN UNWRITTEN RULE THAT YOU NEVER TARGET SHOOT DURING BIG GAME SEASON CLOSE TO WHERE YOU HUNT! Cant fix stupid!!!

Nov 18th: Fished with Joe Stevko and Kenny for 6hrs. Heavy fog wouldn't let me get out where I wanted to go so it was a slow morning but we ended up with 27 fish with 1 walleye and 1 hog nose sucker in the mix.

Nov 17th: Fished with Ed Bardzel for 5 hrs today. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water light stained and 44-45 degrees. I used the musky rod for awhile but no follows. We had 52 on the line and boated 44 with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 16th: No charter, worked on the shooting lanes for my tree stand.

Nov 15th: Fished with Charley Write for 6hrs. We had 45 on the line and boated 42 of them with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 14th: The fish just didn't bite today. Fished 4 hrs with Rich and Tom Rodack. The sky was sunny and the water light stained and 43 degrees. We had maybe 10 fish on the line and boated 6 with 1 walleye in the mix. I blame the Super Moon!

Nov 13th: Fished with Jeff and Denise Crouse. The sky was sunny and the water 42-45 degrees and light stained. We had 62 on the line and landed 50 of them with 2 walleye in the mix.

Nov 12th: Fished with Scott Neith and Steve Litschi today. The sky was sunny and the water was 45 degrees. It was slow in the morning as expected but we made up for it in the afternoon. We had 65 fish on the line and boated 49 of them along with 2 walleye, 1 perch, and 1 northern pike.

Nov 11th: Fished 4hrs with LeeAnn Conaway and her 13yr old son Colby. The sky was overcast with high winds and on/off rain. Very tough fishing conditions. Colby and I caught 21 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix. Colby did an excellent job with his baitcasters in that wind!

Nov 10th: Did a TV show with Wild Pennsylvania with Alan Probst. I've done shows with Alan for 11yrs now but this was the first time I've done one alone with Alan on the camera. I caught many bass but nothing big, however I did it using nearly every Sponsor lure I had with me explaining each one. A great day on the water with Alan. We fished about 3 hrs and I caught 17 fish.

Nov 9th: Fished with Adam Lamey and Ed Bardzel. We had 65 fish on the line and boated 57 of them with 1 walleye in the mix.

Nov 8th: Election day! Went to the gym, then voted, then fished with Brian Esinhower in the afternoon. We caught 20 fish with 1 northern pike in the mix.

Nov 7th: No charter so fished by myself early in the morning, caught 25 fish, took lots of photos of them then went to pick up some buffalo hair jigs from JJ's Jigs.

Nov 6th: Hauled hay for my 2 pet steers today. Should have enough for the winter....

Nov 5th: Fished with Gerry and Mike Donahue. The sky was partly cloudy and the water was dark stained and 49 degrees. We had 69 on the line and boated 54 of them with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 4th: Fished with Bob Lee and his buddy. The sky was mostly overcast with high winds and the water was dark stained but it got up to 50 degrees by the time we left. We had 81 fish on the line and boated 66 of them with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 3rd: Got a hair cut in the morning then fished in the afternoon for a few hours with Gregg Richards. We caught 23 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 2nd. Fished with Rich Myers today. The sky was sunny and the water was dark stained and 48 degrees. We had 75 fish on the line and boated 59 of them with several big quality bass being caught.

Nov 1st: Fished with Doug Denure today. The sky was partly cloudy and the water dark stained and 47 degrees. We caught 22 fish.

Oct Totals: Smallmouth Bass 1586 fish, Walleye 9 fish, Bluegill 17 fish, Northern pike 1 fish, sucker 8 fish, Rock bass 8 fish, Total + 1,629 Fish!

Oct 31st: Fished with Adam LeMay and John Weibley today. The sky was overcast and the water dark stained and 47 degrees. We had 50 fish on the line and boated 32 of the with some big bass being caught.

Oct 30th: Fished with Tom Ferrante today. The sky was cloudy and the water dark stained and 46 degrees. We had 62 on the line and boated 53 of them.

Oct 29th: Fished with Ray Buxton today. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water dark stained and 46 degrees. We had 62 fish on the line and boated 54 of them with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Oct 28th: Fished with Dan Douglas and Corry Lidezuy. The sky was overcast and the water was dirty brown and 45 degrees. We had 49 fish on the line and boated 40 of them with 1 walleye in the mix.

Oct 27th: Nasty day, the guys rescheduled.

Oct 26th: Fished with John Henderson and his buddy today. The sky was overcast and the water was dirty brown and 49 degrees. We caught 34 fish with some nice big quality bass being caught.

Oct 25th. Fished with Ron Jordan and Kasey Singleton. The sky was partly cloudy and the water dirty brown and 50 degrees. We caught 35 fish with some big quality bass

being caught.

Oct 24th: Fished with Tim Miller and Jeff Crouse. The sky was partly cloudy with high winds. The water was still muddy at 52 degrees. We each caught big fish but only 8 made it to the boat mostly in the first 3 hours before the winds hit us. Jeff caught his personal best smallmouth!

Oct 23rd: Fished with Kevin Readinger and Andrew Doyal. The sky was partly cloudy but the wind went up to 17-20mph winds. The river was still muddy and 52 degrees. The boat didn't get skunked but it was still too muddy to fish.

Oct 22nd : no fishing, the river was too bad.

Oct 21st: It rained hard last night. Flash flooding in the creeks all over the county. The river had come up just a foot but was still rising. John Snyder and his son Andrew were with me today. The areas we needed to fish were filling up with debris making it hard to fish. After 2 hours John caught a fish. I looked up the river and saw a debris field second to none coming down and I told the guys that we had to go now! We would go 200ft and the motor would clog up so I would have to clean it off and we would lose half of what we gained. Long story short it took us 2 hrs to get back the 3 miles to the access. The river turned into a muddy swirl filled with trees and debris.

Oct 20th: Was supposed to do a TV show today but again no cameraman for the 4th time this year. I'm starting to get a complex.

Oct 19th: Fished with Russel Decker and Bear. Again we had fog in the morning turning to a sunny day. We had 92 fish on the line and boated 79 of them along with 1 bluegill in the mix.

Oct 18th: Fished with Joe Stevko and Mark. The sky was foggy then sunny. The water was 60 degrees and clear along with very low. We had 49 fish on the line and boated 42 of them with 1 bluegill in the mix.

Oct 17th: Fished with Barney, Lonnie, and Gary today. The sky was fog then sunny and the water 58 degrees and clear. We had 103 fish on the line and boated 85 of them with 2 rock bass and 2 bluegills in the mix,

Oct 16th: Fished with Bill and Mary Salerno today. The sky was partly cloudy and the water was clear and 56 degrees. We had 117 fish on the line and boated 101 of them. Bill was on fire! there was also 5 bluegills and 1 sucker in the mix.

Oct 15th: took the day off to hunt and messed up my foot so couldn't walk....crap!

Oct 14th: Had just a 3hr trip with Dave Sharon. we had 63 on the line and boated 51 of them mostly using wacky worm style

Oct 14th: Fished with Doug, Mike, and Pete. The sky was sunny and the water clear and very low. We had 51 fish on the line and boated 35 of them with 2 bluegills and 1 rock bass in the mix

Oct 13th: Fished with Will Cressman and Will Shaffer today. The sky was overcast with some light rain and the water was clear, 59 degrees and extremely low. The guys took a while getting used to finesse fishing but we had 104 fish on the line and boated 77 of them with 4 suckers in the mix.

Oct 11th & 12th: Fished with Jay Murphey and Ed Bardzel. The sky was bright and sunny. The water clear, very low, and 60 degrees. We had 201 fish on the line and boated 164 of them. Finesse fishing saved the day.

Oct 10th: Fished with Kevin Herzog today. Had a quick drop in temperature, high pressure system and wind. We fished hard for the 25 fish we caught.

Oct 9th: Fished with Kevin Deibert, John Lacy, and Jeff Homer today. The sky was overcast and the water mostly clear and 61 degrees. I didn't fish today and the guys had 68 fish on the line and boated 55 of them with 2 rock bass and 1 bluegill in the mix.

Oct 8th: Fished with Jim DeAngelo and Frank. The sky was partly cloudy and the water mostly clear and 63 degrees. We had 119 fish on the line and boated 102 of them with 1 walleye and 1 sucker in the mix. Another great day!

Oct 7th: It was just myself and my good friend and long time client Ed Nestor today. The sky was foggy then sunny and the water mostly clear and 63 degrees. We had 106 fish on the line and boated 95 of them with 1 walleye, 1 Bluegill and 1 rock bass on the line. Pretty good for 2 people.

Oct 6th: Fished for 4 hours with Doug Roberts and his 4yr old son Doug. The day was sunny and the water light stained. Little Doug is the most advanced 4yr old fisherman I've ever seen. He could cast a spinning rod about as good as most of my adult clients. Today it was all about him and whatever we could do to keep him on fish. He caught 20 fish and lost a bunch more. I had a great time with them today.

Oct 5th: Had a 6hr charter with Dave Flannery and his daughter Erin. The sky was partly cloudy and the water 65 degrees and clear to 4 ft. We had 101 fish on the line and boated 84 of them.

Oct 4th: Fished with John Snyder and Nick Koivras today. The sky was overcast and the water light stained and 63 degrees. We had 155 fish on the line and boated 130 of them with 2 rock bass, 2 suckers, 2 walleyes, and 3 bluegills in the mix.

Oct 3rd: Fished with Bill Kurz and Ed Bardzel today. The sky was overcast and the water clear and 63 degrees. We had 135 fish on the line and boated 112 of them with 1 bluegill and 1 northern pike in the mix.

Oct 2nd: Had a later start today at 12:30PM with Charlie Baum and his dad. The sky was bright sun and the water mostly clear and 65 degrees. We had 63 on the line and boated 48 of them.

Oct 1st: Fished the afternoon with Horace Whitner. The sky was mostly sunny and the water light stained. We had 79 fish on the line and landed 62 of them with 2 walleyes in the mix mostly on Rage Baby Craws and small swim baits.

Sept Totals: Smallmouth bass 1421, Rock Bass 9, Bluegill 10, Walleye 4, channel cat 1, Northern Pike 2, Total fish 1447 fish!

Sept 30th: Fished with Ken Mayberry and . We had 25 fish on the line and caught 18 of them. The fish here were very picky today.

Sept 30th. Fished 4hrs in the morning with Shamus Smith, his dat John, and his 8yr old son, Aiden. It was just a nasty morning with a cold rain and wind, tough fishing! We caught 15 fish but John caught his personal best smallie and Aiden caught his first smallie. They did good just to last that long.

Sept 29th: My wife's birthday, no fishing today!

Sept 28th: had a 4hr trip with Jason Teets and Rick MacNeal this evening. We had 38 on the line and boated 28 of them.

Sept 28th: Fished with Bob and Rob Gunther today. The sky turned sunny and the water a light stain. We had 79 fish on the line and boated 53 of them along with 2 bluegills in the mix.

Sept 27th: Fished with Frank Patla today. The sky turned sunny and the water was light stained, 64 degrees and very low! We had 92 fish on the line and boated 63 of them with 2 bluegills in the mix.

Sept 26th: due to a mess up in communication no fishing today!

Sept 25th: Fished with Leo Parker and Larry Doyle. The sky sunny and the water 67 degrees and light stained. We had 113 fish on the line and boated 103 of them along with 1 northern pike and 1 rock bass.

Sept 24th: Justin Adleff brought his 6yr old son Jaiden for a 3hr instructional trip. We started out with the basics of casting which he did very well and near the end of the 3hrs he was catching his own fish! Good job Jaiden!

Sept 23rd: Took part in the Hunts For Healing fishing day on the river. We had 4 boats each with a captain, mentor, and serviceman. I had Alan Probst with me who was filming for his TV show."Wild Pennsylvania with Alan Probst. When we visited each boat

for an interview, we captured every serviceman catching fish while we were there. I want to thank our 4 captains, Chris Gorsuch, Steve Okula, Rick Gincley, and Pete Phatton for volunteering their boats and their time in this most worthy cause. God Bless our servicemen! There was over 300 fish caught and released!

Sept 22nd: Had outdoor writer John Punola with me for an afternoon trip. We started at the toughest time of the day, 1:30 PM in bright sunlight so we both knew it would not be easy. We boated 43 fish but nothing big enough for photos. John did well with his swim bait and 1/32 oz jig head. Kept it just above the rock moss. Well done.

Sept 21st: It was just Houston Matter and myself today. The sky was again sunny and the water green stained and 72 degrees. We had 68 fish on the line and boated 54 of them along with 1 bluegill in the mix.

Sept 20th: Fished with Scott Page today. The sky started out foggy then bright sun. Water was green stained and 70 degrees. We had 90 fish on the line and boated 76 of them with 2 walleyes and 2 rock bass in the mix.

Sept 19th: Well it came together today! Fished with Harold Stilwater and his son Dan. The sky stayed overcast all day and the water was dark green stained and 70 degrees. We had 142 fish on the line and boated 110 of them! With 2 rock bass and 1 northern pike in the mix!

Sept 18th: Fished with Bill Salerno and his buddy Sal. The sky was sunny and the water the lowest I've ever seen it at a negative number on the river meter, yep, below 0.00ft. We caught had 52 fish on the line and boated 40 of them.

Sept 17th: Extreme low water today for Joe Plennella and myself. The sky was sunny and the water dark green. We had 67 on the line and boated 53 of them with 1 channel cat in the mix.

Sept 16th: Had to reschedule 2 charters today because of the broken drive shaft which is now repaired.

Sept 15th: Started out with the second charter and got about a mile or so up river going over 8ft of clear water and BANG! The drive shaft broke! Never hit anything! As a matter of fact, never hit anything in the last 2 days! Limped back to the access with the trolling motor and called Snake Creek Marine. Took the boat right up to them in Montrose. They ordered the parts and had them overnighted back from CA! They had the parts in the morning and gave me a call at 2:00PM to pick up the boat. Now that's service!

Sept 15th: Fished in the morning for 4hrs with Corey Sickler and his buddy Everal. Corey's wife Yvonne was along for the ride and brought me a plate of Cherry Strudel snacks which tasted great! We had a good time with some tricky boat driving getting up through the shallow water. We had 59 fish on the line and boated 43 of them. The water was 71 degrees and green stained, also very low!

Sept 13 & 14th: Fished with Steve Geringer. and John Friedlund. We did well with 199 fish on the line and we boated 160 of them with 1 walleye and 4 bluegills in the mix! Steve had been fishing with me for 17 years and this was his last trip. Talking about going out on a high note! Thanks Steve!

Sept 12th: Fished with Greg V. and the fish just wouldn't bite today. We caught 17 fish in 6hrs. Well you can't hit home runs every day!

Sept 11th: Went to a family reunion

Sept 10th: Fished with Roy Gerber in the early morning. We had 56 on the line and boated 49 of them.

Sept 9th: Had a 3hr evening trip with a local gent and his daughter in law. We had a blast! Got soaked in the rain and caught only 15 fish but it was fun!

Sept 9th: Fished with Thad Grossman and Heidi Richardson this morning. The sky was sunny and the water low, 77 degrees, and green stained. We had 93 fish on the line and landed 78 of them with 2 rock bass and 1 walleye in the mix.

Sept 8th: Fished with Will Cressman and Bob Bleam today. The sky was sunny and the water low, 77 degrees and dark green. We had 53 on the line and landed 42 of them with 2 rock bass and 1 bluegil in the mix.

Sept 7th: it was just me and Mike Vino today. the sky was sunny and the river is very low, dark green stained, and 77 degrees. We had 54 on the line and boated 32 of them. Rage baby craws and small swim baits caught the fish.

Sept 6th: Taught Justin Adleff how to fish the river today. The river is very low but he did well. We had 57 on the line and landed 41 of them.

Sept 1st -5th: In Maine hunting Bear and fishing

Aug Totals: Small mouth bass 1505 fish, Walleye 10 fish, Blugill 9 fish, Rock bass 4 fish, catfish 3 fish, Northern pike 1 fish, pickerel 25, = 1557 fish!

Aug 26th - 31st. Went up to Maine on a successful bear hunt and fishing trip. smallmouth 15, pickeral 25

Aug 25th: Had a 4hr evening trip with Russel Anderson. We had 49 fish on the line and landed 41 of them with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Aug 25th: Fished with Jack Slocum and his buddy Ira. The sky was overcast and the water dark stained and 75 degrees.. We had 97 fish on the line and boated 75 of them along with 3 bluegills in the mix.

Aug 24th: Fished with John Makenzie and Harold Wright. The sky was sunny and the water dark stained and 76 degrees. We had 103 fish on the line and landed 87 of them with 2 walleyes and a channel cat in the mix.

Aug 23rd: Fished with Ed Bardzel and his sister in law Carol Bardzel. The sky was sunny and the water dark stained and 76 degrees. WE had a great day with 166 fish on the line and boated 141 of them along with 1 walleye, 1 rock bass, and 1 northern pike. Rage Baby Craws along with the Baby craws on a jig spinner caught most of the fish. In the morning we caught some big bass on top water and late afternoon a bunch on small swim baits.

Aug 22nd: Fished with Fred and Josh Stocker. The Sky was mostly sunny and the water had come up and was dark stained. We had 67 fish on the line and boated 56 of them.

Aug 20&21: Didn't fish with the weekend crowd.

Aug 19th: Fished for 3hrs with Tom Henson along with Mike and Russ. Mike and I did most the fishing and had 35 on the line and boated 28 of them.

Aug 18th & 19th: Fished 6 hrs early on each day with Dan Lash and his 13yr old son Dan. The first day I only fished with them a little over an hour. They didn't realize I needed to be invited to fish with them before I did. Both days we had good fishing with a total of 189 fish on the line and we landed 141 of them with 4 walleyes, 3 bluegills, 1 catfish, and 1 rock bass in the mix. Very good guys for your first trip on the "Beast" Rage baby craws, both on a Moaner Predator jig and on a spinner jig caught most of the fish with a few on small cranks.

Aug 17th: My wife Eileen and I had the pleasure of having Matt and Nisa Wilson, owners of Moaner Hooks, fishing with us today. The sky was mostly sunny and the water was dark stained and 79 degrees. This was our annual "Business" meeting so to speak where we talk about what's new on the horizon and just do alot of fishing. We caught 50 bass mostly on Rage Tail plastics and Moaner jigs, but I caught a few on some small cranks as well. For the record, Nisa caught the largest bass!

Aug 16th: Fished an afternoon/evening charter with Walter and Josh Woehrle. The sky was cloudy and the water dark stained and 81 degrees! The guys had 82 fish on the line and boated 64 of them. there were 1 bluegill and 1 rock bass in the mix. I never picked up my rod. Great going guys!

Aug 15th: Fished with Matt Strong and his 2 boys, Connor and Josh from Maryland. The sky was partly cloudy and the water dark stained and 80 degrees. We had 121 fish on the line and boated 87 of them along with 2 bluegills. A great day!

Aug 14th: Had a 6hr early trip with Ray and Bonnie Rohe. The sky was overcast and the water was 81 degrees! They did pretty good once we found a lure that would work well

with their Zeco 202"s . Ended up with 49 fish on the line and boated 33 of them along with 1 channel cat. All on small cranks.

Aug 13th: A short early morning 4 hr trip with Dave Rickles. Boats everywhere! We had 52 on the line and boated 47. Seemed like forever to get back through all the boats and waders to the access.

Aug 12th: My son's birthday, took the day off.

Aug 11th: Fished with Kevin Deibert, Jeff Homer, and John Lacy today. This was their first trip on the Beast and after realizing and obtaining that yes we need fishing licenses even for catch and release we got started.(sorry guys, had to tease a bit). I briefly showed them how I fish the conditions we faced and put down my rod for the day. They had 73 fish on the line and boated 51 of them. Good Job Guys! Rage Baby Craws, both on a jig and jig spinner caught the fish.

Aug 10th: Fished with Rick and Ricky Leibert today. The sky was overcast and we sat the first 2 hours in the rain. The water was dark stained but the rain kept the temp down to a cool 77 degrees and the fish loved it! This makes their 18th year with me. Ricky started with me at age 8 and he is now 26! As Ricky put it "We kicked fish ass today"! We had 151 fish on the line and boated 127 of them. Ricky was a fishing machine, he boated 60 of them himself! So far they are in the lead for the free trip next year and they used just 8hrs instead of the 10 they would be allowed for the contest.

Aug 9th: Fished with Tom Robbins and Linwood Meyers today. The sky was sunny and the water was dark stained and 80 degrees. We had 104 fish on the line and boated 78 of them mostly on Rage Baby Craws rigged on an LD jig spinner.

Aug 8th: Fished with Mike Yakubik and his buddy Bob. The sky was sunny and the water dark stained and 78 degrees. We had 115 fish on the line and boated 85 of them with 1 walleye and 1 rock bass in the mix.

Aug 7th: Fished with John Snyder and his daughter Jenna and grandson Doug. The sky was sunny when we started and the water was dark stained and 77 degrees. We had 50 fish on the line and boated 31 of them.

Aug 6th: Scheduled day off.

Aug 5th, Came back for a 4hr evening trip with Dave Barnes and Terry Witcoff. We had 59 on the line and boated 51 of them! Mostly on Rage Baby Craws. Jigs and Jig spinners.

Aug 5th: Fished with Don Chlebowski and Jim Carbaugh today. The sky was partly cloudy and the water was dark brown stained and 75 degrees. Don fished with his fly rod and never missed a strike! We had 72 fish on the line and boated 58 of them.

Aug 4th: Took the truck to Wilcox Auto for inspection and service. I always get good service there.

Aug 3rd. Came back for an evening trip with Will and Bill Cassome. We had 42 on the line and landed 35 fish.

Aug 3rd: Fished with the Baker boys, Sam, Wally, and Micah for 6 hrs. Always a good time. The sky was sunny and the water brown stained and 79 degrees. We had 49 on the line and boated 38. Could only use jigs because of the floating moss but the Rage Baby Craws came through.

Aug 2nd: Had a great 4hr charter early in the morning with Bruno Walkowiak and Sarah Bilby, their first trip on the river. The water had come up a foot and there was floating rock moss all over the place, the only thing we could use was a jig, and we used Rage Baby Craws. They soon got the hang of it and boated 57 fish out of the 79 we had on the line, good job!

Aug 1st: Fished with Jerry and John Wickhammer. I had a phone interview with an outdoor writer this morning and this was a 4hr evening charter. We had 68 fish on the line and boated 55 in the moss filled water.

July Totals: Small Mouth Bass 1297 fish, Walleye 2 fish, Channel Cats 5 fish, Rock Bass 13 fish, Bluegill 4 fish. Total = 1321 fish!

Chris did very well in the catching department, he even was high stick for the day, but with 1 hand he needed a little help from dad taking the fish off and getting his lure unstuck from the rocks. We caught 51 fish with 4 walleyes and 1 channel cat in the mix.

April 23rd: Fished with Steve and Steven, along with Bob and Bobby, fathers with 11yr old sons. The sky was mostly overcast and the water stained and 56 degrees. We caught 62 fish with 4 walleyes in the mix. A great time had by all.

April 22nd: evening charter with Steve Getsie and his son Steven. We caught 15 fish.

April 22nd: Fished with John Snyder and his friend Duff. The sky was overcast and the water 56 degrees and stained. We caught 51 fish with 1 channel cat and 1 walleye in the mix.

April 21st. Fished with Barry and Jeramie Rittenhouse. The sky was sunny and the water 54 degrees and stained. We caught 57 fish with 1 walleye in the mix.

April 20th: Fished with Gerry and Tom Wickerman. The sky was sunny and the water 53 degrees and stained. We caught 68 fish with 3 walleyes in the mix.

April 19th: 3hre charter with Mike and 10yr old Russel Henson. Grandad Tom came along to watch. We caught 18 fish and Russel did very vell with a jig.

April 19th: Fished with Damian and Ellie Frigano. The sky was mostly cloudy with 15mph winds. The water was stained and 54-56 degrees. We caught 51 fish with 1 walleye and 1 sucker in the mix.

April 18th: Was supposed to film today for my DVD but the cameraman couldn't make it after months of planning.

April 16th: Fished with Glenn Frickmann and Billy Weeks today. The sky was sunny and the water stained and 47 degrees. We caught 31 fish with 3 walleyes in the mix all on Teaser tubes.

April 17th: Client could not come so I asked my wife and we caught 38 fish with 2 walleye in the mix.

April 15th: Jason and Ed Miller came to fish today. The sky was sunny and the water dark stained. The fish bit so well that I didn't pick up a rod all day. The guys caught 35

fish today all on JJ's Jigs Hair jigs. Great job for their first time on the river for smallies.

April 14th: Went by myself today for 3 1/2 hrs just to see what to use for tomorrows charter. I caught 16 bass and 1 walleye on JJ's Hair Jigs, Rage Baby Craws on a Moaner jig and the small Teaser tubes.

April 1st -13th: No fishing, high river. Rescheduled all charters. This is killing me!

March totals: Smallmouth Bass 294, Walleye 12, Northern Pike 5, Quillback 1, Carp 1, Rock Bass 1 = 310 fish

March 31st: Fished 4 hrs with Doug DeNure. The sky was overcast and the wind 20mph. There were very few places we could fish to stay out of the strong winds, the main river had white caps. I fished with Doug for the first hour and stopped to give Doug maximum area to fish. We caught 12 fish with some big ones being caught. The Bear hair jig and Rage Baby Craw catching them.

March 30th: Fished with Ed Bardzel for about 5hrs. The sky was mostly sunny and the water light stained to clear and got up to 46 degrees. We caught 35 fish with 1 walleye and 1 northern pike in the mix. The two best lures were the Bear hair jig from JJ's Jigs and the Rage Baby Craw rigged on a Predator jig head.

March 29th: Fished with Dave Heightman and Larry Windslow today. The sky was sunny and the water light stained. We caught 39 fish with 1 walleye in the mix.

March 23rd: My wife said that she would like to go fishing so I hooked up the Beast and away we went. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water was light stained and 43-45 degrees. We fished for 4hrs and caught 19 fish with 2 northern pike and 1 walleye in the mix. Today the bear hair jig from JJ's Jigs caught most of the fish and a small tube caught the rest.

March 21st: Fished with Tom and Shelly Riggins today for a half day. We caught 29 fish with 1 walleye in the mix.

March 19th: Fished with Randy Graves and Darrel Linspit today. Dark stained water and we caught 30 fish with 1 rock bass in the mix.

March 18th: Fished with Lou Drexel for about 5 hrs today. Dark stained water and we caught 36 fish with 1 carp in the mix.

March 17th: Fished with Lou Richards today for 6hrs. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water dark stained. We caught 32 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix.

March 16th: Fished 6hrs with Dennis Puza today. The sky was overcast and the water dark stained and 44-45 degrees. We caught 22 small mouths on swim jigs and JJ's bear hair jigs.

March 15th: Fished with Adam LeMay for a while. The sky was overcast and the water 43-44 degrees and dark stained. We caught 11 fish with 2 walleye and 1 quillback in the mix.

March 13th: Fished with Adam Slacktish and Brad Zuk. The sky was overcast and the water was 45 degrees and dark stained, the river came up a foot overnight, crested and was now going back down. We caught 11 fish with 2 northern pike and 3 walleye in the mix. A good day under some tough conditions.

March 12th: Fished with Rick Syrauburg today. The water was dark stained and 45 degrees. Tough fishing but we landed 25 fish today including 1 walleye.

March 11th: Fished with 80yr young Doug DeNure today. The sky was mostly cloudy and the river on the rise due to the all day rain yesterday. The water was dark stained and 45-46 degrees. After checking my score card we had caught 14 fish in a little over 4 hours. Doug caught a big one and I caught my first 20" of the season and took some well deserved kidding from Doug for doing so. We caught a couple on small finesse tubes but the majority was caught on a Rage Baby Craw rigged on a Moaner Hook Enraged Shakey jig, weedless so we could fish slow.

March 10th: Sold my 2002 show trailer which was just too big and bought an eight footer to pick up Saturday. Then made some more wood crossed for the wife's business.

March 9th: Fished with Sponsors Adam LaMey and Albert Propst for about 5hrs. The sky was sunny and the water dark stained and 42 degrees. We caught 22 fish, most were 15" to 19" smallies. On the Moaner Enraged Shakey Head with a Rage Baby Craw and small tubes along with JJ's hair jigs.

March 8th: Went to the gym then up to Snake Creek Marine for Oil and fuel additive for the boat.

March 7th: Fished with Ed Bardzel. The sky was mostly sunny and the water dark stained and 35-37 degrees. We caught 10 smallies on Rage Baby craws rigged on the new Enraged 1/4oz #4 jig, small tubes and JJ's Hair jigs.
