Year End Total: Smallmouth Bass 9415, Walleye 258, Musky 7, Largemouth Bass 65, Sucker 11, Rock Bass 114, Carp 4, Channel cat 66, Perch 1, Northern Pike 22, Bluegill 14, Pickerel 40, Total fish caught in 2017 = 10,017 fish

Dec Totals: bass 89, walleye 20, northern pike 6, musky 1, total fish 116

Dec. 10th: The access is all iced up and I can't get the boat on the water so that's it for this season. See you sometime in March 2018! Thanks to all that fished with me!

Dec 9th: Last day of the rifle deer season . Again saw no deer but I did see why maybe there hasn't been any around. In the morning I saw a big bore bear approx 300lbs with his belly dragging the ground and late afternoon I saw 3 more bear in the 150 to 200lb range.

Dec 8th: Haven't been seeing any deer so I went fishing. I caught 7 fish with 2 walleye and 1 baby musky.

Dec 7th: Hunted this morning again saw nothing, fished this afternoon with William Faust. We caught 20 fish with 5 walleye and 1 small pike in the mix, all on Rage Tail Baby Swimmers.

Dec 6th: Fished with Harry and Rick today. We caught 21 fish with 4 walleye in the mix.

Dec 5th: Took Rich Rodack fishing, I didn't fish. Rich caught 8 bass and had 2 big pike right up to the boat just out of my net reach before they bit through the line. He also had one on briefly out at the end of his cast. Sometimes the fish just win.

Dec 4th: Hunted all day, never saw a deer. It's like they all left the woods the woods !

Dec 3rd: Fished with Kevin Readinger today. We caught 15 fish with 3 walleye and 2 northern pike. Kevins pike was 36" very nice!

Dec 2nd: Hunted in the morning, didn't see a thing. Fished in the afternoon with Mike Curry and caught 18 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers rigged on a Moaner Predator jig.

Dec 1st: Fished with John and Jake Remsfield in the afternoon when it got warmed up. We caught 25 fish with 4 walleye and 1 pike in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers.

Nov. Totals: bass 673, walleye 48, northern pike 4, musky 2, channel cat 1, total fish = 728

Nov 30th: Went hunting, didn't see a thing. Should have fished.

Nov 29th: Fished by myself today with Rage Baby Swimmers, rigged on a 2/0 Moaner Hooks Predator jig. Concentrated on the winter holes and caught 27 fish with 1 northern pike and 5 walleyes in the mix, as usual all released.

Nov 28th: went to the gym then hunted, saw 5 doe.

Nov 27th: 1st day of deer season, didn't see a thing.

Nov 26th: Fished with Mike Ritoski today and the fish woke up a bit. We caught 45 fish with 3 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 25th: Dave Sharon came up to fish today. The fish just simply turned off. We caught just 10 fish and Dave caught 8 of them. He also had a small pike in the mix.

Nov 24th: Fished with Ray and John Michell today the sky was partly cloudy and the water was clear and 38 degrees. We caught 53 fish with 4 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 23rd: Happy Thanksgiving!

Nov 22nd: Fished with Terry and Sonia B today. The sky was semi cloudy and the water light stained and 39 degrees. We caught 52 fish with 3 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 21st: Fished for 5hrs with Bill Brothers and Ed Bardzel. The sky was mostly sunny and the water went from 37 to 40 degrees. We caught 40 fish with some big bass being caught on Ragetails Baby Swimmers. Ed and I rigged ours on a 2/0 Moaner Predator jig with no weed guard.

Nov 20th: Fished in the morning with Josh Overpeck. We caught 32 fish with 4 walleyes in the mix all on Rage Baby Swimmers.

Nov 19th: Fished with Dick Kelly today. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water light stained and 39-40 degrees. We caught 39 fish with 5 walleyes in the mix. Rage Baby Swimmers and Adams jerk baits caught the fish.

Nov 18th: First day of Bear season. Didn't see a bear but did see a couple of nice bucks. Hope they stay in the area for deer season.

Nov 17th: Went to pick up my eye glasses early then got a hair cut today. Got home to find a shipment of Rage Baby Swimmers along with some boat and truck decals I needed.

Nov 16th: Chris O'Neil and his dad and brother came to fish for about 3hrs and we got blown off the river. After catching a few fish the wind and rain front hit us and tossed my 21ft boat around like it was a toothpick with 2ft rollers coming up the river. We left and while I was eating lunch alone at the access, the sun came out beautiful so since I didn't fish with the guys, I went back in the river to catch another 17 bass before heading

home on Rage Baby Swimmers.

Nov 15th: Fished with Adam and Alan LaMey today. The sky was mostly clear but windy. The water was light stained and 39 degrees. We caught 27 fish with 1 northern pike and 3 walleye in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers.

Nov 14th: It was just me and Ed Bardzel today in great conditions., The sky was overcast with little wind and the water light stained and 42 degrees. We caught 47 fish with 1 northern Pike and 1 channel cat in the mix.

Nov 13th: Fished with Carl and Rick Swanson. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water light stained and 42 degrees. We caught 53 fish with 4 walleyes in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers, Baby Craws and Adam LD jerk Baits.

Nov 12th: Client rescheduled.

Nov 11th: Veterans Day, thank you to all service people for what you do. Was supposed to take a couple of veterans fishing but no show? It was very cold anyway.

Nov 10th: Fished with Trace and Mary Witherspoon. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water 44 degrees. We caught 47 fish with 4 walleyes in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers and Adams jerk baits.

Nov 9th: Fished with Jon Wiebly and Mike. The sky was mostly overcast and the water stained and 44 degrees. We caught 35 fish with 2 walleyes and many big bass on Rage baby swimmers and Adams jerk baits.

Nov 8th: Fished with Rich Myers today. The sky was sunny and the water stained and 45 degrees. We caught 45 fish with 1 walleye and 1 small musky in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers, baby craws, and Adams jerk baits.

Nov 7th: Went to the gym then went and voted. Worked on the new DVD, caught 12 fish.

Nov 6th: Went to eye doctor in the morning then fishing with Sid Gressom. We caught 32 fish with 4 walleyes in the mix on Rage Baby Swimmers and Adams jerk baits.

Nov 5th: The river was down to 3ft when Phil Gunning and I went fishing today. Cloudy with a light rain for most of the 5 hours we fished. The water was a dark stain. We caught 51 fish with a small musky in the mix. I had a big musky on for just a few seconds before he bit me off. We boated many big bass today. I used a RageTail Baby Craw, a RageTail Baby Swimmer both rigged on a Moaner Hooks Predator jig. I also caught several fish on the new Adams Encount'r jerk bait. (available on my web site).

Nov 4th: Ed Bardzel and I fished a new part of the river today for 5 hrs. The water was still dirty brown with 49 degree water and we caught 15 fish. I won't be going here

tomorrow.

Nov 3rd: The river was at 4ft and 49 degree water dirty brown when Jack Cassidy and I fished it this morning. We caught 28 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix.

Nov 2nd: The river was at 5ft when Big O, Steve Parks , the creator of RageTail plastics came for the challenge. Along with Matt and Nissa Wilson, owners of Moaner Hooks we gave the cold muddy river a try. The water temp got up to 49 degrees making it for tough fishing. We fished for 4hrs and caught 10 fish but this trip was more about just having fun with friends and talking about new products coming in the future. July 17th: Rescheduled our fishing charter because of high muddy water but we fished just to see if we could catch a fish. We caught 29 fish with 3 channel cats in the mix.

July 16th: Filmed at the house for what I hope is the final for the buffalo Western Plains to Eastern Waters DVD.

July 15th: Fished with Dave Pcola and his grandson Nathan. The sky was overcast and the river had come up 2ft and was muddy. We caught 6 fish and lucky we got even that!

July 14th: Had a great time fishing with Lori Parsons and Jamie Barhour today. the sky was mostly cloudy and the water 74 degrees and dark stained. We caught 70 fish today!

July 11th: Fished with Jerry and Frank Odessa. The sky was partly cloudy and the water was dark stained and 74 degrees. We caught 78 fish with 2 walleyes and 2 rock bass in the mix.

July 10th: Had a 6hr afternoon trip with John and Jerry Richardson. Water warmed up to 75 degrees and green stained. We caught 73 fish with 3 walleyes and 1 channel cat in the mix.

July 10th: fished for 4hrs in the morning with Mike Evans. Beautiful day! We were done at 10AM. We caught 31 fish with 1 nice walleye in the mix.

July 9th: Fished with Chris Tanner and Brittney Dimeglio. The sky was semi cloudy and the water stained. We caught 71 fish with 1 channel cat and 1 walleye in the mix.

July 8th: No fishing, went to my nieces wedding.

July 7th: Fished with Scott Leeper. The sky was partly cloudy and the water a dark stain. We caught 55 fish with 2 channel cats and 2 walleyes in the mix.

July 6th: Came back and fished with Mark and David Rextone. We caught 51 fish with 1 channel cat and 1 walleye in the mix.

July 6th: Fished with Gary Ockenhouse and his son. We caught 62 fish with 1 channel cat in the mix.

July 5th: came back and fished with Tom and Jack Wingate. We caught 65 fish with 2 channel cats and 2 walleyes in the mix.

July 1st & 2nd: I usually don't fish on this weekend but I agreed to take out Darran Whittiker from Texas for 4hrs each morning starting at 5:30AM so we missed most of the crazy boaters. We caught 28 fish the first day and 31 the second not bad in the dirty water.

June Totals: Bass 1507, rock bass 52, walleye 24, channel cat 21, sucker 7, bluegill 4, northern pike 5, carp 1, musky 1, Total fish = 1622

June 30th: The rain storm held us off but we did get in about 4hrs with Ryan Krnger and his 11yr old daughter Brooke. We caught 22 fish.

June 29th; Fished with George Brodhead and his grandsons for a few hours. We caught 22 fish with a northern pike in the mix.

June 29th: Did some filming today for my buffalo DVD with Adam LaMey of Adams Custom Lures. Everything had a buffalo hair tail on it and we did great! I caught a small musky on film and Adam caught some really nice bass on his crank baits with the

buffalo tail. We caught over 40 fish total and then did some filming with the drone.

June 28th: Fished with Mike Parks, his daughter Lucy and Nate. We caught 40 fish with 2 channel cats in the mix.

June 28th: Fished again with Ken and Mike. We caught 63 fish with 3 rock bass in the mix.

June 27th: A quick 3hr trip with Ken Lines and Mike Werst. We caught 18 fish

June 26th: Had a fun afternoon with Chris Pack and Deb. The cold front went through and the wind picked up so fishing was tough. We caught 20 fish with 2 rock bass and 1 big channel cat.

June 26th: Took out Todd and Sue Shaffer. The sky was partly cloudy and the water stained and 73 degrees. They caught 32 fish.

June 25th: Came back for a 4 hr evening charter with Ray Chilson. We caught 45 fish with 2 walleye and 1 rock bass in the mix.

June 25th: Took Doug DeNure with his 2 adult grandsons, Dan and Jessie fishing. The sky was partly cloudy and the water stained and 73 degrees. They caught 55 fish with 2 walleye, 3 rock bass and one channel cat in the mix.

June 24th: Fished with Lloyd Vought today. The sky was partly cloudy and the water dark brown. We caught 50 fish with 1 northern pike in the mix.

June 23rd: didn't fish, too many thunder storms to dodge. Worked on the wife's "Honey-do list."

June 7th: My clients drove in and stayed the night before so there was no way to warn them for today's water. It came up another 2 ft overnight and dark brown mud. It was a good thing that my new motor was broke in because I opened up that 250hp Merc to 50mph and beat the storm to the access. Got the clients to their car and it hit us! Hard rain and lightning. Said our quick goodbys and I waited until it slowed down before trying to take out the boat. When I got in it there was about 3" of water in the bottom and the auto bilge was working overtime.

The guys were using their fly rods and did great with 72 fish caught with 5 suckers, 2 rock bass, and 2 bluegills in the mix. June 4th: Fished with Jim De Angelo. Rained all day, water was stained and 61 degrees. We caught 85 fish with 2 walleye, 1 rock bass, and 1 sucker in the mix. 20 were on the Rage Baby Craw rigged on a Moaner Predator jig and 65 were caught on

an Adams Custom Lures crank bait in the Dirty Water Devil pattern.

June 3rd: Came back for a 4hr evening trip with Bill Rockford. We caught 43 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix on Adams cranks and Rage Baby craws.

June 3rd: Fished with Mike Stanewich and Mark. The sky was sunny and the water dark stained and 62 degrees. The morning started off slow then we switched over to the Adams Custom Lures crank bait and the bite was on! We caught 61 fish with 6 walleyes and 1 rock bass in the mix and all but 3 were caught on the Adams crank in the Dirty Water Devil pattern.

June 2nd: Fished a 4hr evening trip with Steve Okula. We caught 25 fish with 1 walleye in the mix.

June 2nd: Fished the morning with Dave Pchola and his grandson Nathan. The sky was mostly sunny and the water was dark stained and 62 degrees. We caught 46 fish with 1 walleye in the mix..

June 1st: Finished up a 3hr trip with Susan Hyde . We caught 17 fish. So that ended me up with 73 total for the day in adverse conditions. Way to go folks!

June 1st:Fished with Jeff and Denise Crouse today. The sky was partly sunny, very windy, and the river was high, fast, and dirty. water temp was 62 degrees. We caught 56 fish today with 1 rock bass in the mix.

May Totals: Bass 1149, walleye 31, rock bass 55, carp 2, channel cat 2, perch 1, musky 1, sucker 3, northern pike 1, Total fish 1245.

May 31st: Happy Birthday to me. Fished with Joe Weibley and his dad Jim. The sky was partly cloudy and the river was on the rise and brown. We caught 60 fish with 2 walleyes and 3 rock bass in the mix. I caught a nice 21" smallie, happy birthday to me.

May 30th: Hit the gym then met Susan and Bill Hyde to fish. We fished for 3 hrs before the thunder got too close. Caught 21 fish with 5 rockies in the mix.

May 29th: Memorial Day. Thank you to all the veterans that gave their all so we can be free!

May 28th: Took the morning off to take flowers to all my relatives grave sites for memorial day. Mowed moms lawn and trimmed my sons hedge. Fished a few hours in the evening with Ray Speckle. We caught 32 fish.

May 27th: Afternoon trip with Walton, Joel, and Josiah. They took the shall we say the long way to get here and had to leave early but the 3 of them caught 30 fish with 5 rock bass in the mix. making it 97 fish for my boat today.

May 27th: Fished in the morning with Ray Trumble. The sky was cloudy and the water stained and 64 degrees. We caught 67 fish and was off the water by noon.

May 26th: Was waiting at the access and my new friend Sue Moss was waiting at another. Easier for me to go there lol. The sky was overcast and the water stained. We caught 72 fish with 3 walleyes and 2 rock bass in the mix on Rage Baby Craws.

May 25th: had a 4hr evening trip with Jason Teets and his son Danny. It was Danny's first trip on the river and the fish came alive big time! The weather calmed down with just a mist and no wind. We caught 60 fish with 25 rock bass in the mix. Making it a total of 91 fish for the day!

May 25th: Fished with Joe Stevco and Ken. Rain and high winds hurt our 6hr trip but we still caught some nice bass and 1 northern pike for a count of 31.

May 24th: Fished the evening charter with Bill Salerno and Al. We caught 54 fish with 2 walleyes, 1 rock bass, and 1 sucker in the mix.

May 24th: Fished with Jim Kremer and Richard. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water stained and 64 degrees. We caught 53 fish with 4 walleyes and 1 channel cat in the mix.

May 23rd: came back and fished the evening with Mike and Sally Greenwich. We caught 58 fish with 3 rock bass and 2 walleye in the mix.

May 10th: Fished with Todd and Mike Fetterolf. The sky was partly cloudy and the water was high and dark stained. We caught 41 fish with 1 carp, 1 walleye, 1 channel cat and 1 perch in the mix mostly on black Rage Baby craws and black tubes.

May 9th: River too high so after my gym work out I took the boat up to Snake Creek Marine for some new trolling batteries and another case of oil. Back on the water tomorrow!

May 8th: River still too high so went for a hair cut then went to watch my son with his new video drone.

May 7th: Water too high, rescheduled

May 6th, high water so rescheduled.

May 5th: Fished again with Jason and his dad. We were in a constant rain and wind but the fish were on fire! We fished 2 1/2 hrs with 40 fish and 3 walleyes in the mix. We would have continued but the rain was getting worse and the 4 reels that they brought were binding up in the rain. Their equipment gave in before they did!

April Total: Smallmouth Bass 484 fish, Lg mouth Bass 28, Walleye 12, Musky 1, Sucker 1, rock bass 1, Total 527 fish, High muddy water!

April 30th: Fished a short day with Steve and Steven again. The sky was overcast with some sprinkles a couple of times and the water dark stained and 60 degrees. We caught 58 fish with 1 walleye in the mix.

April 29th: Fished with Steve Getsie and his son Steven. The sky was mostly cloudy and the water was dark stained. We caught 81 fish with 1 walleye and 1 rock bass in the mix on Rage Baby Craws, Adams Custom Lures crank baits, and teaser tubes.

April 28th: cancellation darn it! Time to get caught up on the honey-do list. Nope, Called a friend and we caught 62 fish with 3 walleyes in the mix. Thanks Rick.

April 27th: Filming today for the buffalo DVD. Fished only with buffalo jigs. Caught just 8 fish but I did get a nice 20" bass on film. Have 2 more filming sessions to film before this one comes together.

April 26th: Fished with Barney Cook and Lonnie. Always a fun time with these guys. The sky was partly sunny and the water dark stained and 55 degrees. We caught 57 fish with 1 walleye in the mix on teaser tubes and ned rigs.

April 25th: Invited a buddy to fish. The sky was mostly sunny. The water dark stained, a bit high and 53 degrees. We caught 59 fish with 1 walleye and 1 musky in the mix. Mostly on Rage Baby craws and Ned rigs.

April 24th: Charter cancelled, wow, river just a ripping! Muddy & high! Lucky to get the 15 fish I caught!

April 23rd: River is high so fished at the farm pond to get 15 bass, I just needed to catch some fish!

April 22nd: River is dropping but it's at 11 foot! I'll be lucky to go fishing 5 days from now!

April 21st: Rained hard during the night and even more so in NY. When my client and I arrived at the river it had come up a couple of feet and mud! We decided to reschedule. The river kept on rising during the day and crested at a little over 11ft! That's 6ft higher than I like to take out clients in!

April 20th: Had the day saved for an outdoor writer that couldn't make it. Crap! Looks like rain anyway.

April 19th: Fished the morning with Bob and Sue Little. The sky was mostly cloudy and

the water stained and 55 degrees. This was their first time fishing and we had a blast! Once they learned how to cast the fish started getting caught. We caught 54 fish with 2 walleyes in the mix. Nothing real big but that didn't matter to them.

April 18th: Fished with Jim Murphy and his son Evan. The sky was sunny and the water stained. Evan was new to river fishing but he got the hang of it and did just fine. We caught 27 fish today mostly on Ned rigs but I caught 2 big bass on the Adams Custom Lures crank bait.

April 17th: Fished with Colby Conaway and his mom Lee Ann. The sky was mostly sunny and the water dark stained and 54 degrees. We caught 28 fish and Colby brought along his drone for some great camera footage.

April 16th: Happy Easter, spent the day with my relatives.

April 15th: Fished for a while with Frank Gresson this morning. The sky was partly cloudy and the water dark stained and 51 degrees. We caught 32 fish with 2 walleye in the mix.

April 14th: Fished with Chris and Ryan again today. The sky was semi cloudy and the water was dark stained and 50 degrees. We caught 17 fish with 1 sucker in the mix. Several big quality bass were caught again today on hair jigs, Rage Baby Craws, and Snagler Spinner Baits.

April 13th: Fished with Chris Porch and his 12 yr old son Ryan. The sky was mostly cloudy with a constant cold wind. The water was high, fast, and dark stained. We caught 14 fish with 1 walleye in the mix. Had a big carp on for a while but lost it also one of the biggest bass I've seen in a while won it's fight with the young angler. We had to work for the fish but we caught some big ones! The mud at the ramp is deep!

April 12th: River still high at 6 1/2 ft but Sponsor Adam LaMey of Adams Custom Lures and I gave it a try. The sky was partly cloudy and the water was high, fast, dark stained and 49 degrees. We caught 15 bass and 1 walleye all on a black/blue Rage Baby Craw rigged on a Moaner Predator jig.

April 11th: River too high to take out a client at 7 1/2ft, but not too high to take a buddy. Ed Bardzel and I zig zagged around the floating trees and debris to try it today. The sky was sunny and the water high, fast, and dirty brown. We caught 15 bass in the 5hrs we were out so it was tough fishing. Biggest was 18". Caught on a blue claw Rage Baby Craw and a small black swim bait. Felt good to get back on the water but we weren't prepared for the sun, we both got burnt!

April 10th: River still too high to fish, so I took my truck to get serviced when I still had the chance.

April 9th: River too high, 17 bass at the farm pond

April 8th: Had to go to my farm pond for a fishing fix. Caught 13 large mouth bass. The biggest was 20" on an Adams Crank.

April 7th: River going up to flood stage at 16ft, that's 10ft too high! It will be up into the parking lot! CRAP!

March totals: Bass 1, Walleye 1, Musky 1, total fish 3 . Isn't that depressing!

March 25th: And then the rain came and the snow melted. The river came up too high and hasn't gone back down.

March 21st: Went over to the ramp on the way back from the gym this morning and there was still 9" to 12" of snow on the access road but I had to try it first. Only got stuck 4 times coming back out to the main road! I'll check it again this coming weekend, there is supposed to be some warm weather coming to melt the snow. Just hope the river doesn't rise too much with the melt off.

March 18th: Went to a Game dinner at New Milford to hear my good friend Randy Flannery give a seminar. Still can't get to the river because of deep snow. This is killing me because the river itself is fishable.

March 14th, the BIG Snow, over 30" around here, can't do anything!

March 7th: With the winter sports expo's over for me I contacted my buddy Ed Bardzel to try out the river. The water was a bit high and fast with a dark stain and 36 degree water temp. It didn't matter because I mainly wanted to try out the boat after getting it back from Snake Creek Marine for it's early spring check up. The boat worked great but as expected the fishing was very slow. I was mainly using my big musky rod hoping for a musky bite. I asked Ed to use our regular jigs in the meantime to try and catch anything so we wouldn't get skunked. I was also throwing some cranks and spinner baits knowing the water was too cold for the fish to chase but I use all Sponsor baits every time I fish regardless of the conditions. We fished a total of 3 hours or so and it was at 2 hours that Ed caught a beautiful 26", 6lb walleye on a Rage Baby Craw rigged on a Moaner Predator jig. I couldn't stand it no longer so I picked up my light baitcasting rod which was also rigged with a Rage Baby Craw and with the first cast I thought I had a big log but it was coming in. All the sudden it took off and I had a big musky on the line. After about 15 min I got it tired out so it could be netted . My cradle net has a 60" measure on it and I saw it was over 48" so we called it 49+". After several photos I released it unharmed for the next lucky angler. While I was posting it on line, Ed caught a 17" smallmouth and we called it a day.
